

Freedom to Provide Wellness Services

Unlicensed persons willing to comply with the mandated prohibitions and disclosures of the Iowa Access to Wellness Act (IAWA) will be free to diagnose and treat according to their expertise and training.

Mandated Prohibitions & Disclosures

An unlicensed health care provider...

1. SHALL NOT:
 - a. Perform surgery or any procedure that harmfully invades the skin.
 - b. Prescribe or administer x-ray radiation, drugs, or controlled substances or devices.
 - c. Cause an imminent or discernible risk of serious bodily injury, serious physical or mental illness, or death.
 - d. Represent ones self as being a licensed health care professional.
2. MUST DISCLOSE in writing:
 - a. That they are not a licensed health care provider.
 - b. The nature of diagnoses and treatments to be provided.
 - c. Their education, training and other qualifications.
 - d. If they have surrendered or had a health care license revoked.
 - e. If they have been convicted of a sexual or violent crime, or of a crime against a minor.

Benefits to Iowans

- Local access to a wider range of providers and approaches to wellness through the natural/holistic healing arts
- Greater public awareness of the full range of wellness options
- Empowerment for making thoughtful, informed decisions about what healing arts services to use
- Self-determination in maintaining wellness and wellbeing
- Safe, cost effective alternatives to conventional medical care
